Patio Extensions At Lilac Festival 2009



Any 4th Street Business requiring special event space, including **patio extensions** **MUST** submit requests to the BRZ office by April 27th at the very latest to ensure application is processed in time for event day. **Please complete the following steps:**

1. Make drawings of the proposed extension with measurements, seating, etc.
2. Submit drawings & letter of intent to the BRZ office for approval. Letter of intent should include type of fencing, security being used and hours of operation.
3. Once approval from the BRZ is obtained you must take the drawings, intent letter and BRZ approval letter to the AGLC to obtain your permit. **You must have this patio extension permit for AGLC in order to expand your patio during Lilac Festival.**
