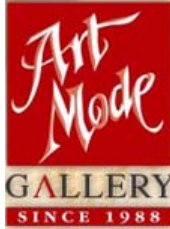

Dumpsters In Alleyways

This is important information for all 4th Street BRZ Business Owners

There is as most of you know an ongoing issue with regards to dumpsters in alleys behind businesses and newspaper boxes in front of buildings along 4th Street SW.

Please be advised that if you have a graffiti-covered dumpster in the alley behind your business, check your contract or call your supplier to inquire about cleaning.

Typically you are entitled to request that at least **ONCE PER YEAR**; your dumpster provider will either clean your dumpster inside and out or replace your dumpster with a clean, graffiti-free dumpster **AT NO COST TO YOUR BUSINESS**. Although this boon is usually in your contract, this service is rarely provided unless specifically requested.

The providers of newspaper boxes in front of your businesses are also similarly obliged to keep the boxes clean and in good condition. If you have any concerns regarding the matter of newspaper boxes please call the 4th Street BRZ office at 229-0902.

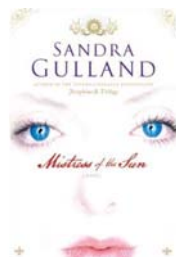
