Development Project – Community Update

The 2004 – 4th Street Development Project is committed to providing the public and stakeholders with as much information as possible. The following outlines primary construction activities for the month.

August 2008:

Piling has been completed and we thank the community of Mission for their patience and understanding during this phase of the construction project.

September 2008:

Excavation activities will continue through September to remove earth down to lower parkade level.

Tower crane delivery and set-up is scheduled to begin on Wednesday, September 17th and will require a temporary sidewalk closure on 21st Avenue. Once the crane is in place, residents can expect to see an increase in traffic as deliveries of building materials for the foundation work will occur.
